

2018 Tuition Fee Schedule – International Students



This 2018 Tuition Fee Schedule is effective from 1 January 2018 and replaces all Schedules previously issued. Tuition Fees are reviewed annually and can increase from year to year.

Tuition Fees for each unit of study are calculated per credit point. Except where otherwise indicated, examples of “Fee per Unit” in the Schedule assume a standard unit of **6 credit points**. Individual units may, however, have a credit point value different to the standard value – please check the **Student Handbook** (<https://handbook.cqu.edu.au/>) for information on credit points for each unit.

Students are advised to check the **Calendar of Principal Dates** in the **Student Handbook** (<https://handbook.cqu.edu.au/>) each term for information about the last date to withdraw without financial liability. NOTE: These dates apply to ALL STUDENTS (international and domestic).
