Accessing eduroam using an Android Pixel Device

eduroam is a service that enables CQUniversity students and staff to connect to a secure wireless network while on campus and when visiting other educational institutions around the world. This makes it possible to travel (for work or study purposes) and connect to the internet.

- 1. Click the "**Settings**" icon from the list of all applications on your Android Pixel device.
- 2. Select the "Network and Internet" option.
- 3. Select the "**Wi-Fi**" option. *The phone will search for available wireless networks.*
- 4. Select "eduroam" from the list of available networks. eduroam is available at most Australian Universities.
- When prompted select the following options to configure eduroam.
 EAP Method: PEAP
 Phase 2 Authentications: MSCHAPV2
 CA Certificate: leave as default (Use system certificates)
 Online Certificate Status: Do Not Verify
 Domain: cqu.edu.au
- 6. Enter your CQUniversity email address in the

field titled **Identity** as described below.

- 7. Enter your CQUniversity password in the field titled **Password**.
