

# CQUniversity ASEAN Student Scholarship

The CQUniversity ASEAN Student Scholarship is a highly competitive scholarship offering 50 per cent off tuition fees for eligible undergraduate and postgraduate coursework and research courses at CQUniversity Australia.

This scholarship is limited and awarded to high-achieving international students who demonstrate strong academic performance, leadership potential, and a commitment to making a positive impact in their community or chosen field.

Designed to recognise future changemakers from ASEAN countries in Southeast Asia, the scholarship supports motivated students to access a world-class Australian education while investing in their long-term career success.

## ELIGIBILITY

1. Citizenship
  - a. This scholarship is available to students who hold a citizenship from a Southeast Asian country.
2. Academic achievement
  - a. Have achieved a minimum grade average of 75 per cent or equivalent, as assessed by the University.
  - b. Academic results must place the applicant within the top tier of eligible applicants from the region.
3. Scholarship statement - Submit a 2-minute or less video outlining:
  - a. Why they consider themselves deserving of the CQUniversity ASEAN Student Scholarship.
  - b. Evidence of academic excellence, leadership potential, and/or impact beyond the classroom.
  - c. How the scholarship will support their academic and career aspirations.

## SELECTION PROCESS

1. Meeting minimum eligibility requirements does not guarantee an award.
2. Successful recipients will be selected based on academic merit, creativity in the short video and overall strength of application.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All CQUniversity ASEAN Student Scholarship recipients are governed by these terms and conditions.

1. The scholarship is awarded, at the discretion of the University, to international students, undertaking study at CQUniversity Australia.
2. The scholarship is only available to new to CQUniversity students commencing studies in 2026 for full degree, packaged academic courses and research.
3. The scholarship cannot be deferred and is valid only for commencement in 2026.
4. Recipients must remain enrolled full-time and continue to meet ongoing academic progression requirements, as outlined in the scholarship terms and conditions.
5. The scholarship is not available in conjunction with any other CQUniversity Australia scholarship.
6. The scholarship is not transferable to a third party or redeemable for cash.
7. The scholarship is calculated and applied on a per unit basis.
8. The scholarship remains valid whilst the recipient:
  - a. remains enrolled in compulsory terms at CQUniversity Australia;
  - b. pays all tuition and additional fees/costs in accordance with CQUniversity Australia policy, ensuring tuition fees are paid in full by census date each term;
  - c. meets the conditions of their student visa (if applicant on student visa).
9. The scholarship will discontinue if the student named on the Letter of Offer:
  - a. has overdue tuition fees and/or outstanding debts after census date of each term;
  - b. is identified as being at Level 3 of Academic Progression on their enrolment;
  - c. graduates from their nominated course; or cancels their enrolment, or has their enrolment cancelled at CQUniversity Australia.
10. As per the refund policy, refund amounts payable to international students may be adjusted to include the recouping of waived published fees such as the repayment of any International Merit Scholarship in accordance with the terms and conditions of those scholarships.
11. If an international student cancels their studies at the University prior to the completion of their studies as per their Letter of Offer and COE and/or, if an international student transfers to a different Education Provider, the international

student must repay the CQUniversity SEA Changemaker Scholarship fees for each term that was completed. Fees owing may be deducted from any refund that is payable by the University or an invoice for the amount of scholarship deducted for each relevant term prior to the request for cancellation will be sent to the student for payment.

12. The scholarship may be withdrawn with 10 days' written notice, should the recipient breach any of these terms and conditions.
13. The scholarship is not available to international students undertaking the Bachelor of Aviation (Commercial Pilot).

## **APPEALS**

1. There is no right of appeal should the applicant be unsuccessful in securing a scholarship or has their scholarship withdrawn.
