# Form Instructions

## PURPOSE

This form helps you assess your eligibility for entry into the Bachelor of Psychological Science (Honours). It calculates your Grade Point Average (GPA) based on your best second- and third-year APAC-accredited psychology units.

## HOW TO USE

### 1. Select your Units

- Enter the grade for your third-year Research Methods, Statistics or equivalent unit in the first row.
- Choose nine (9) additional second- and third-year APAC-accredited psychology units that you've completed.
- If you have fewer than 10 eligible units, you must enter at least 8 second- and third-year APAC-accredited psychology units – for the remaining blank rows, keep 'Select' in the Grade Point Value column.
- If you have received a credit transfer or exemption for a second- or third-year APAC accredited psychology unit, select 'Exempt' in the Grade Point Value column. Do not enter zero (0), as this will negatively affect your GPA calculation.

### 2. Fill in the table, ensuring you populate the following details for each individual unit:

- Institution – where you completed the unit
- Psychology Unit Code – e.g. PSYC13016
- Psychology Unit Name – e.g. Cognitive Psychology
- Year Completed – what year you completed the unit e.g. 2022
- Grade Point Value – use the conversion table below

### 3. Order your Units

- List your units from highest grade to lowest grade.

### 4. Your GPA

- The form will automatically calculate your Grade Point Average (GPA).

### 5. Submit your application

- If your GPA is above the minimum requirement of 5.5, we welcome you to apply.
- Please upload a copy of your completed form with your application.

## GRADE CONVERSION GUIDE

If your grades are not already in a seven (7)-point GPA format, convert them using this table:

Mark Range	Grade Description	Grade Point Value
100 - 84.50	High Distinction (HD)	7
84.49 - 74.50	Distinction (D)	6
74.49 - 64.50	Credit (C)	5
64.49 - 49.50	Pass (P)	4
Below 49.50	Fail (F)	0

If your transcript uses a Weighted Average Mark (WAM) or another grading system, you must convert each grade to the GPA scale above before entering it into the form.

### Important Notes

- Only include second- and third-year APAC-accredited psychology units.
- Do not include first-year units or non-psychology electives.
- If you repeated a unit, use the most recent grade.
