General Terms and Eligibility:

- 1. The promoter is CQUniversity Australia (CQU), Bruce Highway, Rockhampton QLD 4701.
- 2. Competition entries open on Tuesday, 1 October 2024 and close at 11.59 pm on Monday, 14 October 2024.
- 3. Every entry will be considered by the judging panel and will be assessed on style, grammar, originality, entertainment value and relevance.
- 4. 35 winners will be selected and notified by 5pm Friday, 18 October 2024 via email and phone. Winners must confirm attendance by 5pm Monday, 21 October 2024. Failure to confirm attendance will result in forfeiting your place in the workshop.
- 5. All entrants must be available to attend the workshop at Cairns Basketball, 289 Aumuller St, Cairns, on Tuesday, 12 November 2024 from 8.40am to 1 pm.
- 6. Students must be currently completing Year 10, 11 or 12 and be an Australian resident. CQU employees and their immediate family members are ineligible.
- 7. By entering the competition, entrants will have accepted all terms and conditions.
- 8. To be eligible to win the prize, entrants must submit their completed entry online.
- 9. One written entry will be accepted per student.
- 10. Prizes are not transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash.
- 11. The promoter will not be held responsible for the loss, theft, damage or equipment failure to any prize after it has been collected by the prize winner, nor for any injury that results directly or indirectly from this competition.
