LICENCES AND CERTIFICATES

CPR CERTIFICATE

Placement providers require students to attend nationally recognised training to provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). The certificate delivers the skills and knowledge for persons to provide life support in an emergency until qualified assistance arrives.

REQUIREMENT

You are required to provide evidence of completing the provide CPR certificate from a nationally recognised training organisation in Australia.

The approved form of evidence (what to submit in Sonia) is to be submitted before the closing date that is designated for the WIL placement unit. It is mandatory for students to maintain current evidence for the duration of their course.

VALID: 1 year

WHAT TO SUBMIT TO SONIA

Your provide CPR certificate from a nationally recognised training organisation (NRT) in Australia that displays the NRT logo.

Your evidence must be current and not expired.

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

Provide first aid courses include the CPR component and this is valid for 1 year from the certificate date of issue. Until your first aid certificate expires (3 years), you are required to attend the provide CPR course every 12 months.
