

Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship

The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship offers a 25% course fee reduction to offshore international students from Southeast Asian countries.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship recipients are governed by these terms and conditions.

- 1. The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship is awarded, at the discretion of the University, to international students, undertaking study at CQUniversity Australia.
- The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship is only available to students applying for vocational, research, full degree and packaged academic course.
- The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship is only available to students new to CQUniversity Australia OR to
 CQUniversity students who have completed a CQUniversity qualification at diploma, undergraduate, postgraduate
 coursework level and applying to commence another qualification at CQUniversity if they meet the minimum eligibility
 criteria.
- 4. The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship is not available in conjunction with any other CQUniversity Australia scholarship.
- 5. The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship is not available to any student who has been given entrance to CQUniversity Australia based on work experience.
- 6. The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship is not transferable to a third party or redeemable for cash.
- 7. The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship is calculated and applied on a per unit basis.
- 8. The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship remains valid whilst the recipient:
 - a. remains enrolled in compulsory terms at CQUniversity Australia;
 - b. pays all tuition and additional fees/costs in accordance with CQUniversity Australia policy, ensuring tuition fees are paid in full by census date each term;
 - c. meets the conditions of their student visa (if applicant on student visa).
- 9. The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship will discontinue if the student named on the Letter of Offer:
 - a. has overdue tuition fees and/or outstanding debts after census date of each term;
 - b. is identified as being at Level 3 of Academic Progression on their enrolment;
 - c. graduates from their nominated course; or cancels their enrolment, or has their enrolment cancelled at CQUniversity Australia.
- 10. As per the refund policy, refund amounts payable to international students may be adjusted to include the recouping of waived published fees such as the repayment of any Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship in accordance with the terms and conditions of those scholarships.
- 11. If an international student cancels their studies at CQUniversity prior to the completion of their studies as per their Letter of Offer and COE and/or, if an international student transfers to a different Education Provider, the international student must repay the Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship fees for each term that was completed. Fees owing may be deducted from any refund that is payable by the University or an invoice for the amount of Scholarship deducted for each relevant term prior to the request for cancellation will be sent to the student for payment.
- 12. The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship may be withdrawn with 10 days' written notice, should the recipient breach any of these terms and conditions.
- 13. The Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship is not available to international students undertaking the Bachelor of Aviation (Commercial Pilot).

APPEALS

1. There is no right of appeal should the applicant be unsuccessful in securing a scholarship or has their scholarship withdrawn.

The terms and conditions may be changed at any time, and the University will provide 20 working days' written notice to all current Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship recipients. Students who are uncertain about any of the terms and conditions, are encouraged to speak to the Student Experience team at their campus.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To receive the Southeast Asia Excellence Scholarship, you must be a new international student and apply from outside Australia. Additionally, you must be a citizen of one of the following Southeast Asian countries: Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Timor-Leste (East Timor), or Vietnam.

All applicants will be automatically assessed by CQUniversity's International Admissions team, and the scholarship outcome will be confirmed in the Letter of Offer.
