eduroam is a service that enables CQuniversity students and staff to connect to a secure wireless network while on campus and while visting other education institutions around the world. This makes it possible to travel (for work or study purposes) and connect to the internet. You can find out where eduroam is available in Australia at https://admin.eduroam.edu.au/geolocate

How To Connect to eduroam using Windows 10

- 1. Click on the **Wireless Network** icon in the system tray. eduroam will appear in the list of available networks.
- 2. Click on eduroam.
- 3. Click on Connect.
- 4. When prompted enter your username and password as described below. In the Username field you must enter your CQUniversity Email Address.

In the password field please enter your **CQUniversity password**.

- 6. A message may appear asking if you expect to find eduroam in this location, click **Connect**.
- 7. You are now be connected to eduroam via your Windows 10 computer.
