

Accessing eduroam using Windows 10

eduroam is a service that enables CQUniversity students and staff to connect to a secure wireless network while on campus and while visiting other education institutions around the world. This makes it possible to travel (for work or study purposes) and connect to the internet. You can find out where eduroam is available in Australia at <https://admin.eduroam.edu.au/geolocate>

How To Connect to eduroam using Windows 10

1. Click on the **Wireless Network** icon in the system tray. eduroam will appear in the list of available networks.
2. Click on **eduroam**.
3. Click on **Connect**.
4. Enter your CQUniversity username and password details as described below:



In the username field you must enter your username followed by “@cqu.edu.au”

Example: (username)@cqu.edu.au

Student: 876543212@cqu.edu.au

Staff: smithj@cqu.edu.au

5. Click **OK**.
6. A message may appear asking if you expect to find eduroam in this location, click **Connect**.
