LICENCES AND CERTIFICATES

FIRST AID CERTIFICATE

Placement providers require students to attend nationally recognised training to provide First Aid responses and life support. The certificate delivers the skills and knowledge for persons to stay calm in an emergency until qualified assistance arrives.

REQUIREMENT

You are required to provide evidence of completing the provide First Aid certificate from a nationally recognised training organisation in Australia.

The approved form of evidence (what to submit in Sonia) is to be submitted before the closing date that is designated for the WIL placement unit. It is mandatory for students to maintain current evidence for the duration of their course.

VALID: 3 years

WHAT TO SUBMIT TO SONIA

Your provide first aid certificate from a nationally recognised training organisation (NRT) in Australia that displays the NRT logo.

Your evidence must be current and not expired.

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

CL91 – Bachelor of Nursing Students are required to submit a First Aid Certificate once only and are not required to renew. Students must submit a current First Aid Certificate in their first year of study with CQUniversity.

For all other Courses, the First Aid component of your First Aid certificate is valid for 3 (three) years from the certificate date of issue.

The CPR component of your First Aid certificate is valid for 1 (one) year from the certificate date of issue.
