

WHAT IS AN EARLY CHILDHOOD TEACHER?

An Early Childhood Teacher is a degree qualified professional who works in early childhood education and care settings to support the development of pre-school aged children and deliver educational programs based on the Early Years Learning Framework.

Early Childhood Teachers' focus is holistic – integrating all dimensions of children's learning including physical, personal, social, emotional and spiritual wellbeing and cognitive aspects of learning. Early childhood teachers are committed to practice that support children's learning in partnership with children and their families.

COURSE STRUCTURE

You will complete a total of 8 units that address the curriculum content and professional experience requirements outlined by the Australian Children's Education & Care Quality Authority (ACECQA).

The course develops professional knowledge, practice and skills for working with the Early Years Learning Framework for Australia with children from birth to prior to school age.

TERM 1

- » Examining the Early Childhood Education and Care Context
- » Play, Purpose and Pedagogy
- » Working with Infants and Toddlers
- » Early Language, Literacy and the Creative Arts

TERM 2

- » Curious Learners: Exploring STEM and Sustainability
- » Responding to Difference: Children, Families and Communities
- » Leadership in the Contemporary Early Childhood Policy Landscape
- » Creating a Supportive Learning Environment

REAL-WORLD OPPORTUNITIES

The course includes work-integrated learning placements in childcare/early learning centres. There are 60 days of placement completed over three placements:

TERM 1

- » 15-day placement with children birth to 24 months
- » 15-day placement with children 3 4 years

TERM 2

» 30-day placement with children 4 − 5 years

CAREER

This course includes units that address the curriculum content and professional experience requirements outlined by the Australian Children's Education and Care Quality Authority (ACECQA) to equip you as an Early Childhood Teacher.

PROFESSIONAL ACCREDITATION

The Graduate Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care is currently pending approval by the Australian Children's Education & Care Quality Authority (ACECQA) for employment purposes as an Early Childhood Teacher in childcare/early learning centres across Australia.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

ACADEMIC

To be considered for entry into this course, you must demonstrate the following:

- » a 3-year Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) Bachelor degree, or overseas equivalent qualification, with a minimum overall Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0; or
- » a relevant Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care qualification plus a minimum of five years of documented, relevant employment experience in a leadership position within an early childhood setting (e.g. Activity Group Leader, Head Teacher, Centre Director, Educational Leader, Group Leader).

Employment experience must be shown in a statement of service, which is presented on a company letterhead, signed and dated by a delegated authority from within the organisation (e.g. line supervisor or human resource officer). The statement must contain your full name, position title, duties performed, employment start date (mm/yyyy) and end date (mm/yyyy), or stating you are still employed, if applicable.

ENGLISH

Minimum academic IELTS (or equivalent) of 6.5 with no individual band score of less than 6.5 in each of the four components (listening, reading, writing and speaking).

If you do not satisfy the entry requirements, you will need to undertake an English language proficiency test.

English entry requirements can be met by showing an approved English language test, such as the IELTS or equivalent. Visit: **cqu.edu.au/englishreq**
