HEALTH AUTHORITY COMPLIANCE

PREPARATION FOR PLACEMENT

As a part of workplace health and safety legislated obligations, State and Territory Government Health Departments must ensure that students are adequately orientated to their facilities. Health Authority Compliance mandatory checks are determined by each State or Territory Government Health Department. Health Authority Compliance may include online orientation modules, checklists, or other documentation completed prior to placements.

REQUIREMENT

You are required to provide evidence in relation to the completion of the relevant health authority compliance requirements that apply for the state or territory where you will undertake placement.

Students located in Queensland must complete the Queensland Health compliance requirements. For students who reside outside of Queensland, the WIL team will confirm the health authority requirements that will apply for your course which will be visible in your Sonia placement system profile.

The approved form of evidence (what to submit in Sonia) is to be submitted before the closing date that is designated for the WIL placement unit. It is mandatory for students to maintain current evidence for the duration of their course.

VALID: 1 year, and some requirements are per placement.

QUEENSLAND

Health Authority Compliance Requirements

Students attending placement in Queensland are required to complete mandatory Queensland Health Authority Compliance by the mandatory check closing date for your course.

Please note: If the following mandatory checks are assigned to your Sonia profile, completion is required by students attending <u>all placements sites</u> in Queensland.

The Queensland Health Student Deed Poll is required to be completed for every placement at a Queensland Health Facility. This mandatory check will become available once you are allocated to a Queensland Health facility for placement.

How do I submit evidence to this mandatory check?

The Queensland Health Student Orientation checklist and the Record of Allied Health Student Training are both completed by submitting your evidence to a Sonia e-form, rather than submitting the documents to the assigned mandatory check. This e-form can be found on the forms page of your Sonia profile, by selecting the drop-down menu. Please assign yourself the **Queensland Health Documents Declaration and Upload e-form** to upload your evidence.

Once you have uploaded your completed documents to the e-form and ticked agree to the acknowledgements & declarations, this will automatically sign off the mandatory check.
