STILL IN SCHOOL AND WANT TO GET A HEAD START?

Start Uni Now (SUN)

SUN offers Year 10¹, 11 and 12 students the opportunity to study CQUniversity units from university-level courses while still in secondary school. Your studies may also contribute towards your Certificate of Education (eg. QCE, WACE, SACE, or VCE). In Victoria, completion of eligible SUN units may also give you credit toward the calculation of your ATAR. You can enrol in a range of units, either on campus (face-to-face) or online, and combine them with your regular school work. After successful completion of a SUN unit, you may be eligible to apply for direct entry into your preferred course (excluding quota managed courses) and receive credit toward your degree. For more information, visit cqu.edu.au/sun.

Start TAFE Now (STN)

STN is ideal for Year 11 and 12 students, providing an opportunity to study certificate I, certificate II, and certificate III level courses in a wide variety of disciplines.

Benefit from developing real trade skills and qualifications, while completing secondary school. In Queensland, you can study a TAFE course as part of your Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE), and earn QCE points. To be eligible, you need to be at least 15 years of age at the commencement of classes. For more information visit cqu.edu.au/stn.

Year 11 students can include a TAFE certificate III qualification or higher to contribute to the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR).

CQUniversity has options available for high schools who have teachers interested in delivering TAFE qualifications at their school in their area of expertise or specialisation. To discuss partnership opportunities, please email stn@cqu.edu.au.

APPRENTICESHIPS AND TRAINEESHIPS

The steps to becoming an apprentice or trainee are different to becoming a student at university or TAFE.

Generally, you will be required to find an employer who is willing to employ you as an apprentice or trainee. During your apprenticeship or traineeship, your employer (or Group Training Organisation /Job Services Australia provider) may arrange for you to undertake vocational education and training at CQUniversity.

Alternate entry pathways

Whether you're looking to meet prerequisite subjects, need a stepping stone to your dream degree and career or simply want to build your confidence before starting study, CQU is here to help.

PRINCIPAL'S RECOMMENDATION SCHEME (PRS)

Our Principal's Recommendation Scheme allows current Year 12 students to apply to a CQUniversity course based on the written recommendation of their high school principal rather than an ATAR. To find out more, including PRS application opening and closing dates, visit cqu.edu.au/prs.

SKILLS FOR TERTIARY EDUCATION PREPARATORY STUDIES (STEPS)

STEPS is a Centrelink-approved enabling program that can help you gain entry into university. Our SUN program is a valuable alternate entry pathway for high school students thinking about studying a CQU course. After successful completion of a SUN unit during your senior high school years, you may be eligible to apply for direct entry into your preferred course (excluding quota managed courses) and receive credit toward your degree. START TAFE NOW (STN) AND VET QUALIFICATIONS

Completing a STN or VET qualification can provide an alternate pathway into university. Completing a certificate III or IV, or diploma qualification will allow you to obtain a selection rank, which may meet specified entry score requirements for many of our degrees.

If you have a completed VET qualification and you've also completed the necessary subjects to receive an ATAR, you will receive two ranks: a selection rank for your VET qualification, and an ATAR. When you apply to study with CQU, your application will be assessed on whichever score is highest.

PREPARATORY VET COURSES
