Applications for Australia Awards Scholarships are received by Australian embassies or offices contracted to administer the scholarships on behalf of DFAT in a number of different countries.

- > For application information specific to your country, visit <u>australiaawards.com.au</u>.
- Find the CQUniversity course that interests you and meets the priority area for your country.
- Indicate your preferred course and 'Central Queensland University' as your first preferred institution on your application.
- Submit your application directly to the Australia Awards managing office in your country or online at the Online Australia Scholarships Information System (OASIS) at <u>oasis.dfat.gov.au</u>.
- Each Australia Awards office has a different assessment process. If you are successful for the scholarship, you will be notified by the Australia Awards office in your country. The office will then apply on your behalf.
