



International Alumni Scholarship

The International Alumni Scholarship is available to all recent CQUniversity Australia graduates who wish to undertake a new full degree academic coursework program and meet the academic and English criteria at CQUniversity.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All International Alumni Scholarship recipients are governed by these terms and conditions.

- The International Alumni Scholarship is awarded, at the discretion of the University, to international students who have recently graduated from CQUniversity and wish to undertake further study at CQUniversity.
- 2. The International Alumni Scholarship is only available to students applying for a coursework or research higher degree.
- 3. The International Alumni Scholarship is only available to recent graduates of CQUniversity applying to commence another qualification at CQUniversity if they meet the minimum eligibility criteria.
- 4. The International Alumni Scholarship is not available in conjunction with any other CQUniversity Australia scholarship.
- 5. The International Alumni Scholarship is not available to any student who has been given entrance to CQUniversity Australia based on work experience.
- 6. The International Alumni Scholarship is not transferable to a third party or redeemable for cash.
- 7. The International Alumni Scholarship is calculated and applied on a per unit basis.
- 8. The International Alumni Scholarship remains valid whilst the recipient:
 - a. remains enrolled in compulsory terms at CQUniversity Australia;
 - b. pays all tuition and additional fees/costs in accordance with CQUniversity Australia policy, ensuring tuition fees are paid in full by census date each term;
 - c. meets the conditions of their student visa (if applicant on student visa).
- 9. The International Alumni Scholarship will discontinue if the student named on the Letter of Offer:
 - a. has overdue tuition fees and/or outstanding debts after census date of each term;
 - b. is identified as being at Level 3 of Academic Progression on their enrolment;
 - c. graduates from their nominated course; or cancels their enrolment, or has their enrolment cancelled at CQUniversity Australia.
- 10. As per the refund policy, refund amounts payable to international students may be adjusted to include the recouping of waived published fees such as the repayment of any International Alumni Scholarship in accordance with the terms and conditions of those scholarships.
- 11. If an international student cancels their studies at CQUniversity prior to the completion of their studies as per their Letter of Offer and COE and/or, if an international student transfers to a different Education Provider, the international student must repay the International Alumni Scholarship fees for each term that was completed. Fees owing may be deducted from any refund that is payable by the University or an invoice for the amount of Scholarship deducted for each relevant term prior to the request for cancellation will be sent to the student for payment.
- 12. The International Alumni Scholarship may be withdrawn with 10 days' written notice, should the recipient breach any of these terms and conditions.
- 13. The International Alumni Scholarship is not available to international students undertaking the Bachelor of Aviation (Commercial Pilot).

APPEALS

1. There is no right of appeal should the applicant be unsuccessful in securing a scholarship or has their scholarship withdrawn.

The terms and conditions may be changed at any time and the University will provide 20 working days' written notice to all current International Alumni Scholarship recipients. Students who are uncertain about any of the terms and conditions, are encouraged to speak to the Student Experience team at their campus.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The International Alumni Scholarship is available to all recent CQUniversity graduates who wish to undertake a new full degree academic coursework program and meet the academic and English criteria at CQUniversity Australia.

All applicants will be assessed by CQUniversity's International Admission team and applicants will be notified accordingly within the Letter of Offer. The scholarship offered will be a 30% reduction on the applicant's tuition fees for the duration of the course.

This scholarship is not available to students who use an education agent to assist with their application. Students who wish to use an education agent can apply for the International Merit Scholarship.
