

PRE-DEPARTURE CHECKLIST FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

ESSENTIAL THINGS TO DO BEFORE LEAVING HOME	
Arrange your student visa	
Arrange for immunisations and medications from your doctor	
Apply for a credit card and/or arrange sufficient funds. Confirm overseas access to your funds with your bank.	
Organise Australian currency for your first few days (no more than \$2,000)	
Book flights and arrange travel insurance (this is separate from your OSHC)	
Arrange accommodation	
Arrange transport from the airport to your accommodation	
Know what you can and cannot bring into Australia <u>Australian Customs and Quarantine</u>	
Pack your bags, making sure to include the following important documents:	
□ Passport	
 Other formal identification (e.g. country ID card, driver's license, birth certificate) 	
Letter of offer from CQUniversity	
A copy of your Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE)	
 Your OSHC policy number and proof of OSHC (if arranged yourself) 	
 Certified copies of your qualifications and certificates 	
 Written medical advice for any existing medical conditions, preferably in English.

Completing these tasks before you leave home prepares you to start your study journey as soon as you arrive in Australia.	
Log into MyCQU student portal https://my.cqu.edu.au	
Username	
Your <i>student email address</i> or <i>student ID number</i> . You can find your student ID number on your CoE in the Student Details (Section C).	
 Password Your password is in the following format: sDDMMYY# 1. A lowercase 's' 2. Your birthdate in DDMMYY format 3. A hash (#) 	
Examples:	
1 March 2002 s010302# 15 November 1996 s151196#	
You will likely be prompted to complete two-factor authentication when you log in, which will send a text or call to your current phone number.

Log into Moodle and complete the Foundations of Academic Integrity	
Moodle provides resources for each unit which you are enrolled in. To access Moodle, log into MyCQU and click the Moodle link or visit moodle.cqu.edu.au.	
You must complete the Foundations of Academic Integrity module before you can access the Moodle site for each of your units.

THINGS TO DO WHEN YOU ARRIVE IN AUSTRALIA	
You must complete these tasks as soon as you can after you arrive for your safe and to meet the requirements of your student visa.	ty
Call home to let your family and friends know you arrived safely.	
Obtain an Australian SIM card and phone number	
Buying and activating a SIM card will give you an Australian phone number, which you must provide to CQU within 7 days of your arrival.	
SIM cards can be bought from a variety of places in the airport and in your city:	
☐ Supermarkets (e.g. Woolworths, Coles)	
□ Newsagencies	
☐ Convenience stores (e.g. 7/11)	
□ Department stores (e.g. Kmart, Target, Big W)	
☐ Provider stores (e.g. Optus store, Telstra store)	
Obtain a Unique Student Identifier (USI) <u>usi.gov.au</u> All Australian international students are required to obtain a USI. This is also needed to complete the check-in form below.	
Complete the <u>CQUniversity check-in form</u> This updates your details in CQUniversity's systems and confirms that you are in Australia.	
Register for CQUniversity Orientation	
Organise your OSHC Card Download the MyBupa app or contact your arranged OSHC provider.	
Open an Australian bank account Some banks such as Commonwealth Bank allow you to open an account while still offshore, but most will require you to present at a bank in-person.	
Apply for a Tax File Number (TFN) www.ato.gov.au This is required if you plan to work in Australia.	
Start settling in	
☐ Settle into accommodation/search for permanent accommodation	
☐ Purchase household items and food	
Enrol children in school (if required)	



THINGS TO DO WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT CQUNIVERSITY	
Organise your student ID card (and campus access card, if applicable) You can apply for your student ID card once you have enrolled in units. You must update your Australian contact details via the check-in/form before your ID card can be issued.	
Register for CQUniversity Orientation	
Attend orientation	
Orientation is compulsory for all international students. Find out more on the <u>orientation page</u> .	
Connect to the CQU Wi-Fi network (eduroam)	
Username: <i>Your <u>student</u> email address</i> Password: <i>Your MyCQU password</i>	
Complete the <u>CQUniversity check-in form</u> This updates your details in CQUniversity's systems and confirms that you are in Australia.	
Purchase your textbooks For new textbooks, visit the <u>CQUniversity bookshop website</u> and use the unit code for each unit to locate prescribed and recommended textbooks.	
Secondhand textbooks may be sold by past students and advertised online or on-campus, though you must ensure that the textbook is the correct edition for your unit.	
Get involved in student life and activities There are many <u>clubs and societies to join at CQU</u>
