Organise some Australian currency for your first few days (perhaps no more than \$2,000)	
Book flights and arrange travel insurance	
Arrange accommodation	
Arrange transport from the airport to your accommodation	
Know what you can and can't bring into Australia – <u>Australian Customs and Quarantine</u>	
Pack your bags being sure to include the following important documents:

Letter of Offer from CQU	
A copy of your Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE)	
Your OSHC policy number and proof of OSHC (if you arranged it yourself)	
Certified copies of your qualifications & certificates	
 Other formal identification (country ID card, driver's license, birth certificate) 	
 Written medical advice for any existing medical conditions, preferably in English
