

Principal's Recommendation Scheme

CQUniversity's Principal's Recommendation Scheme (PRS) provides Year 12 students with an alternate entry pathway to a wide range of CQU courses. Year 12 students can apply for a course and receive an unconditional* offer based on the recommendation of their school Principal, rather than an ATAR.

With entry based on a Principal's recommendation, the PRS recognises that factors such as motivation, talent and passion play an important role in student success at university.

BENEFITS OF THE SCHEME

The Principal's Recommendation Scheme is an ideal entry pathway for all Year 12 students, whether they are on track for an ATAR or not.

The Scheme gives students certainty about their study options after school with entry based on the recommendation of their school Principal, rather than their ATAR result. Plus, with applications opening in August and offers commencing from early September, students can receive an unconditional offer for a CQU course before their senior results are released.

WHAT TO INCLUDE ON THE RECOMMENDATION LETTER

To be accepted, the Principal's recommendation letter must:

- > be on school letterhead
- > be signed and dated by the Principal
- > list the student's full name
- list the name of the course that the student is being recommended for.

COURSES WITH ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

CL91 - Bachelor of Nursing

Students will need to complete an additional declaration in relation to English language requirements.

CC14 - Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood)

CC12 - Bachelor of Education (Primary)

CC13 - Bachelor of Education (Secondary)

Students applying for one of the Bachelor of Education courses in Early Childhood, Primary or Secondary, will still need to meet the pre-requisite subject requirements of English (Units 3 and 4, C) and General Mathematics, Mathematical Methods or Specialist Mathematics (Units 3 and 4, C). Conditional offers only will be made for these courses.

CC41 - Diploma of Music

CG51 - Bachelor of Music

CG72 - Bachelor of Theatre

Students will need to meet non-academic entry requirements and complete an audition. Conditional offers only will be made for these courses.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

All other undergraduate courses are open to applications via the Scheme.

HOW TO APPLY

The application process is simple and fast. Students apply direct to CQU and attach their school Principal's recommendation letter with their online application.

WHEN TO APPLY

Term 1 2026 applications

- > Applications open: Friday 1 August 2025
- > Offers released: from Monday 1 September 2025
- > Applications close: Monday 1 December 2025
