To address industry gaps in higher-level technical skills, Manufacturing Skills Queensland has partnered with Central Queensland University to subsidise Associate Degree in Engineering cadetship places. This program integrates employment with advanced-level studies.

To celebrate the launch of this program, Manufacturing Skills Queensland is proud to offer a scholarship in partnership with Jobs Fraser Coast to a woman in manufacturing to undertake advanced skills training with work.

The successful applicant will be awarded with:

- A scholarship for the Associate Degree in Engineering through Manufacturing Skills Queensland's Engineering Cadetship program operated in partnership with CQU.
