

Terms and conditions.

JANUARY 2026 TAFE CAREERS EXPO COMPETITION

General terms and eligibility.

- 1. The promoter is CQUniversity Australia, Bruce Highway, Rockhampton QLD 4701.
- 2. The competition is open throughout the duration of CQUniversity's 2025/26 TAFE Careers Expo Campaign, commencing Monday, 1 May 2025, and concluding at 5 pm AEST on Wednesday, 21 January 2026.
- 3. By entering the competition, entrants will have accepted all terms and conditions.
- 4. To be eligible to win the prize, entrants must register their interest via the website or submit a completed entry form at one of the CQUniversity TAFE Careers Expo events and provide a valid email and phone number.
- 5. Entrants must be Australian residents.
- 6. Only one entry is allowed and will be accepted per registration. One additional entry is allowable for entry on the day per attendee. Any other multiple entries will be deemed invalid.
- 7. CQUniversity employees and their immediate family members are ineligible to enter the competition or win the prize.
- 8. Prizes are not transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash.
- 9. The promoter will not be held responsible for the loss, theft, damage or equipment failure to any prize after it has been collected by the prize winner, nor for any injury that results directly or indirectly from this competition.
